**Set graduation requirements** 

- Adopt discipline code for the district
- **Expel students**

SCHOOL COUNCIL

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**Set attendance boundaries for schools** 



 Set and implement discipline practices for the school

· Assign students to classes within the school

#### **STAFF**

Hire and evaluate the superintendent

- Hire/contract with board attorney
- Establish job descriptions for all staff
- **Grant leaves of absences for staff**



· Works with superintendent to hire SCHOOL COUNCIL school principal

- Decide number of people in each position in the school
- Assign staff time

## **MONEY**

- Impose local taxes and set district budget
- Allocate resources to each school
- Set salary schedule for all district staff



- Set the school budget
- Use funding from school board to purchase materials & other student support needs

#### **EXTRAS**

- Approve field trips and fundraisers
- Approve new extracurricular activities



- Select extracurricular activities offered at school
- Set participation requirements for extracurricular activities


## **FACILITIES**

# SCHOOL BOARDS SCHOOL COUNCILS MAJOR ROLES

Providing quality education to Kentucky children is a team effort involving many partners. This brochure explores key roles and responsibilities given to local school boards and local school councils.

The Kentucky Constitution grants responsibility to the **General Assembly** for the creation and funding of an efficient system of public education. Under that authority, the legislature has created the **Kentucky Board of Education**, **local school boards**, elected by the local community, and **site-based decision-making councils**. These local school councils are comprised of the principal, as chair, and three **teachers** elected by teachers and two **parents** elected by parents.

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This is a general outline of school board and school council responsibilities and is not meant to be all-inclusive or to cover all situations boards and councils may encounter.
